How to setup live-streaming with YouTube for online teaching

(the quick and easy way)

- 1. Setup YouTube account
 - a. Go to YouTube and start live stream
 - b. You might have to set up a YouTube account to be able to run a live stream
 - c. You have to activate live streaming
 - d. Helpful information
 - i. https://support.google.com/youtube/answer/9227510
 - ii. Note: Enabling a live stream for the first time may take up to 24 hours. Once enabled, your stream can go live instantly.
- 2. How to set up for streaming
 - a. WEBCAM streaming
 - b. STREAM with streaming software
 - i. Stream key ("Create new stream key" to have a fixed stream key anytime you want to run a live stream)
 - ii. Use stream key to set up OBS (see below)
 - iii. Share link of stream however means you want

 - b. Resource intensive
 - c. Setup:
 - i. Settings: Output, Audio, Video
 - ii. Settings: Streaming
 - iii. Scenes: Display Capture, Video Capture Device
 - iv. Start Streaming, Stop Streaming
 - v. Note: OBS can also be used as screen capture software
